

# Privacy Policy

This privacy statement describes how Science in Boston, a service provided by STEMCELL Technologies Inc. (STEMCELL), collects and uses the personal information you provide on our website: [www.scienceinboston.com](http://www.scienceinboston.com). It also describes the choices available to you regarding our use of your personal information and how you can access and update this information.

## Collection and Use of Personal Information

We collect contact information such as name, email address, mailing address, and phone number. We also collect the following personal information from you:

- Information about your business such as company name and business type
- Demographic information such as education, interests and zip code

As is true of most websites, we automatically gather information about your computer such as your IP address, browser type, referring/exit pages, and operating system and store it in log files.

We may combine this automatically collected log information with other information we collect about you. We do this to improve services we offer you.

We use this information to:

- Send general communications
- Send you newsletters
- Send you promotional communications
- Provide products and services to you
- Recommend products and services that Science in Boston believes will be of interest and provide value to you

## Tell-A-Friend

If you choose to use our referral service to tell a friend about our site, we will ask you for your friend's name and email address. We will automatically send your friend a one-time email

inviting him or her to visit the site. Science in Boston stores this information for the sole purpose of sending this one-time email and tracking the success of our referral program.

### **Information Sharing**

We will share your personal information including your email address with third parties only in the ways that are described in this privacy statement. We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

We may provide your personal information including your email address to companies that provide services to help us with our business activities such as shipping a prize. These companies are authorized to use your personal information only as necessary to provide these services to us.

In certain situations, Science in Boston may be required to disclose personal data in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements.

We may also disclose your personal information as required by law such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process, when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request, if STEMCELL is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, you will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on our Web site of any change in ownership or uses of your personal information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your personal information, to any other third party with your prior consent to do so.

### **Tracking Technologies**

Technologies such as: cookies, beacons, tags and scripts are used by Science in Boston and our online support providers. These technologies are used in analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We may receive reports based on the use of these technologies by these companies on an individual as well as aggregated basis.

We use cookies to monitor website performance, to remember users' preferences, and for authentication. Users can control the use of cookies at the individual browser level. If you reject cookies, you may still use our site, but your ability to use some features or areas of our site may be limited.

### **LSOs**

Third parties such as Ecsource.jove.com, with whom we partner to provide certain features on our site or to display advertising based upon your web browsing activity, use LSOs such as HTML5 to collect and store information.

### **Targeted Ads**

We partner with a third party to either display advertising on our web site or to manage our advertising on other sites. Our third party partner may use technologies such as cookies to gather information about your activities on this site and other sites in order to provide you advertising based upon your browsing activities and interests. If you wish to not have this information used for the purpose of serving you interest-based ads, you may [opt out](#). Please note this does not opt you out of being served ads. You will continue to receive generic ads.

### **Links to Other Web Sites**

### **Social Media Widgets**

Our web site includes Social Media Features, such as the Facebook button [and Widgets, such as interactive mini-programs that run on our site]. These Features may collect your IP address, which page you are visiting on our site, and may set a cookie to enable the Feature to function properly. Social Media Features and Widgets are either hosted by a third party or hosted directly on our Site. Your interactions with these Features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing it.

### **Surveys or Contests**

From time-to-time we may provide you the opportunity to participate in surveys on our site. If you participate, we will request certain personal information from you. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary and you therefore have a choice whether or not to disclose this information. The requested information typically includes contact information (such as name and shipping address), and demographic information (such as zip code).

We use this information to notify contest winners and award prizes, to send participants an email, or to collect customer testimonials.

### **Security**

The security of your personal information is important to us. We follow generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it.
