ONE-DAY VISIT

Salem

Walk the cobbled streets of this famous seaport and explore its complex past at the Salem Witch Museum and Witch House. Stroll along the waterfront at Derby Wharf, browse local shops and galleries, and dive deeper into maritime history at the Peabody Essex Museum. End the day with cozy pub fare downtown or get spellbound by one of their nightly Ghost Tours.

Cape Cod

Find yourself immersed in forty miles of sandy beaches and marshes dotted with historic seaside towns. Take in the fresh ocean air while sampling some of New England's iconic clam chowder. Wind your way through ponds, meadows, and pastures along the Nauset, Head of the Meadow, and Province Lands bike trails. Extend your stay by hopping on a ferry south to Martha's Vineyard, an island known for its traditional New England cottages and natural beauty.

Great Meadows National Wildlife Refuge

Ideal for nature lovers, this wildlife refuge sits in the heart of Massachusetts. It serves as a peaceful escape from the bustling Boston city life. The 3,600 acres boast a diverse collection of wetlands, meadows, ponds, and forests. This is the perfect stop for avid bird watchers, hikers, nature photographers, and nature enthusiasts alike!

OVERNIGHT VISIT

Mystic, Connecticut

This trip isn't just for fans of Mystic Pizza. Mystic is a cozy village rich with maritime history and a walkable town center, perfect for enjoying the picturesque New England landscape and architecture. Check out the Mystic Seaport Museum, Mystic River Bascule Bridge, and the Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center to round out your day before ending at a brewery for a crisp drink and fresh seafood dinner.

Providence, Rhode Island

Just a hop, skip, and jump away from Boston is the capital of the U.S.'s tiniest state. A quieter corner of New England, Providence's thriving art community is reflected in its colorful downtown streets and vibrant neighborhoods. Visit the RISD Museum and the numerous galleries around town to spark your own creativity before strolling through Brown University and College Hill. Don't forget to fit in a riverwalk before you go!

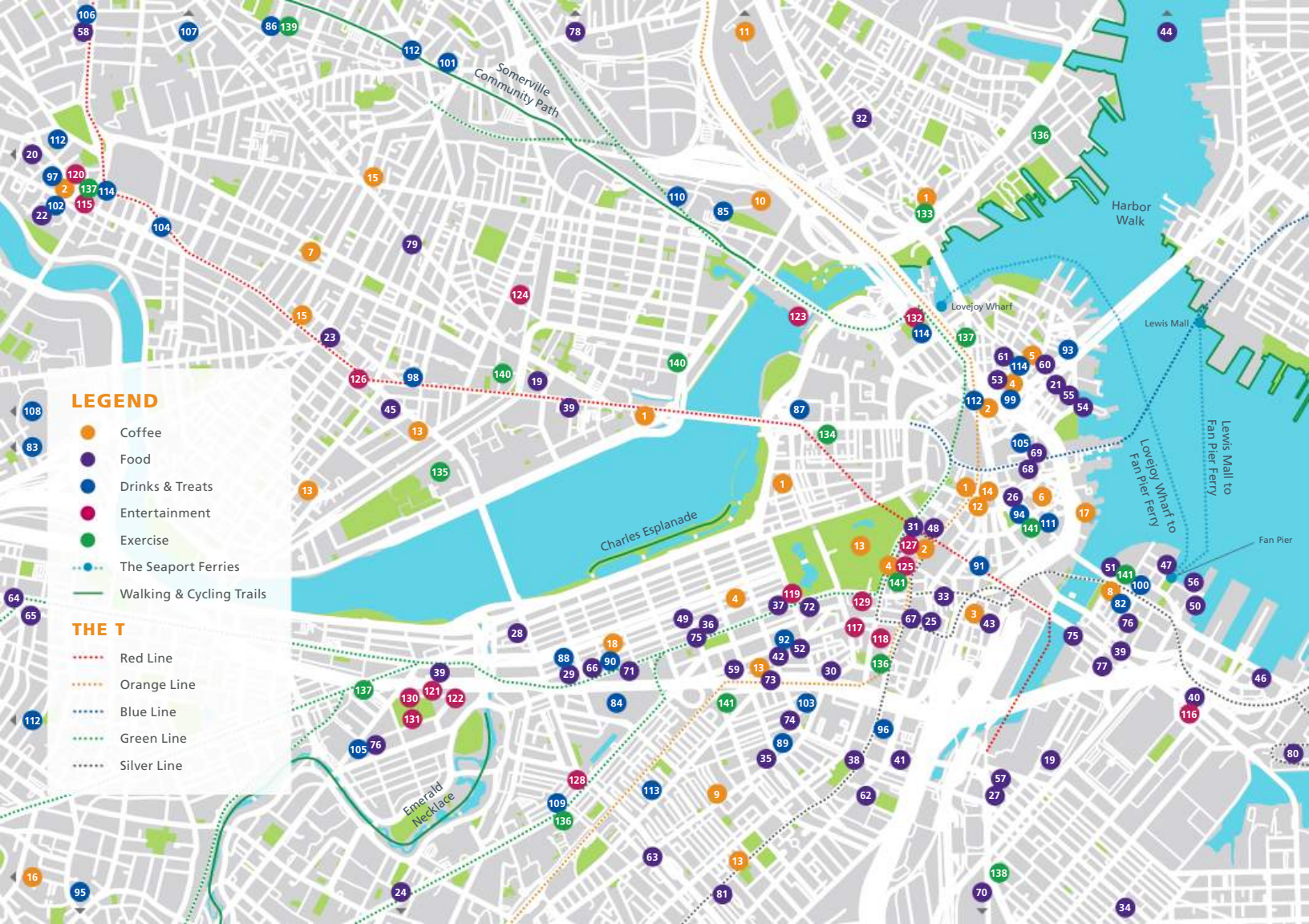
Portland, Maine
